Dear Parents,

We're excited to share everything you need to know about this year's **Eagle Run**—a long-standing tradition at AJS that celebrates fitness, fun, and school spirit! This packet includes important information to help you plan for the big day. We encourage all parents to attend and get involved!

What is Eagle Run?

Eagle Run has been a beloved AJS tradition for over 30 years—combining fitness, fun, and fundraising! Students run or walk laps during a scheduled part of the day. The remainder of their Eagle Run day is filled with learning experiences from health, fitness and safety-oriented special guests. Eagle Run is one of the school's primary fundraisers and provides students a healthy learning experience!

How Do Students Raise Money?

Donations can be cash, check, or collected online through the FundHub website.

- Register on the **FundHub website** and customize your student's page to collect funds online. More information on how to use the FundHub website is included in this packet.
 - **Cash and checks will be returned to school** in the included donation envelope. Make checks payable to AJS-PTO.
 - Our school **fundraising goal is \$33,000**. The **goal per child is \$80.00**.
 - Final donations are due by **November 13**.
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What Happens on Eagle Run Day?

- **Eagle Run t-shirts** will be provided to all students and staff.
 - **9:00 AM – Opening Ceremony**
Enjoy banners, our Eagle Run Flag, and presentations by the Honor Guard and community guests. Note: Strollers are not permitted in the gym due to space limitations.
 - **10:30 AM – 2:00 PM – Fitness Activities + Run**
Students rotate through fitness stations and run with their class. You're invited to walk with your child and help tally laps using markers provided (each lap is marked on a tally sheet pinned to the back of their shirt). A full schedule will be sent home closer to the event.
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What About Lunch?

- **Students eat in their classrooms** (bring a lunch or take a provided sack lunch).
- **Cafeteria = Hospitality Café** for parents, guests, and staff. Students may not eat in this area.
- **Parents are welcome to eat with their child** in the classroom, but **please don't bring food from the Hospitality Café** due to allergy concerns.
- **Volunteers are needed** in classrooms so teachers can enjoy lunch in the Hospitality Café. Let your child's teacher know if you're available.
